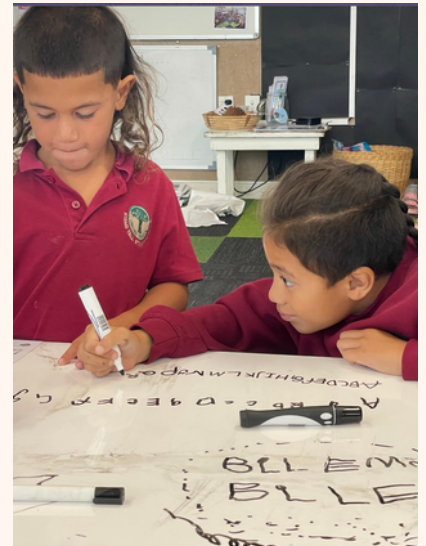
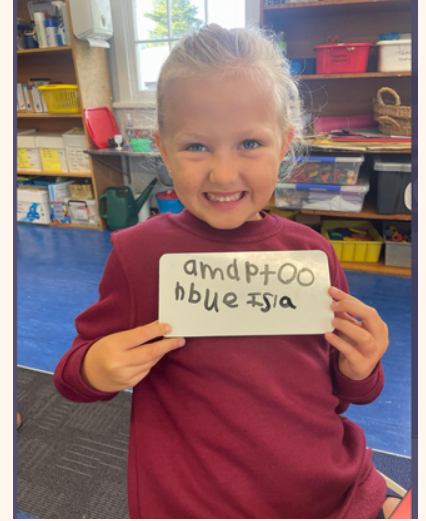

Life Ed- Big Hit!

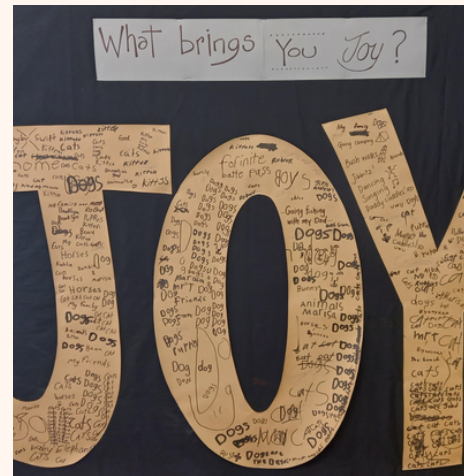
